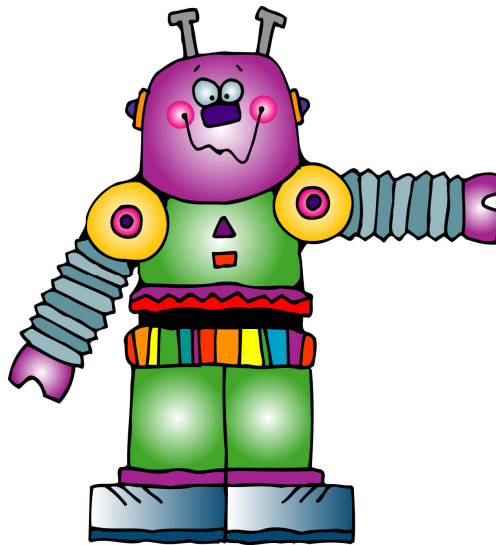

Students in 1st – 5th grades who returned their library books on-time at the end of last school year are eligible to check out three books rather than just two during the first grading period. Students new to the district will also be allowed three checkouts.

For students to continue to check out three books they must return or renew their books on the day the books are due. A book is overdue if it is not returned or brought in to be renewed at least one week after the date it is due. So, if a book is due Sept. 1, and the book is forgotten on Sept. 1, the student can return or renew the book on or before Sept. 8 (one week) and still be in good standing. It is only when a book is two weeks past the due date that an overdue notice will be issued.

During the second grading period (mid-Oct. through December) students will be eligible to have three check outs, if they have received 0 overdue notices during the first grading period.

During the third grading period (Jan.-mid-Mar.) students will be eligible to have three check outs, if they have received 0 overdue notices during the second grading period.

During the fourth grading period (Mid-Mar. to the end of the school year) students will be eligible to have three check outs, if they have received 0 overdue notices during the third grading period.

Students with 0 overdue notices during the fourth grading period will earn an additional week to check out books at the end of the school year.

If a student is a current R.O.B.O.T. club member, the student will be permitted to only check out 2 books, if the student has a current overdue book.
